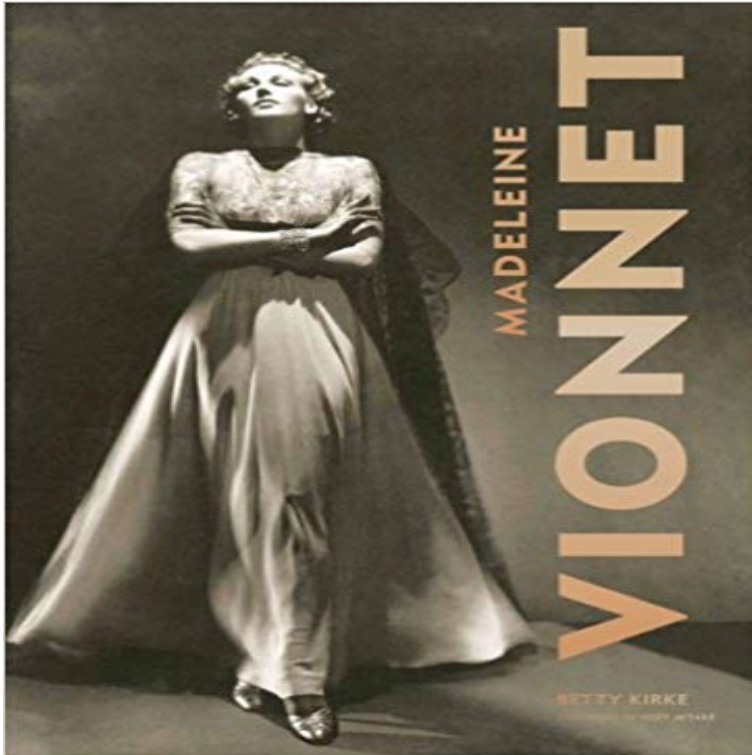


Madeleine Vionnet
