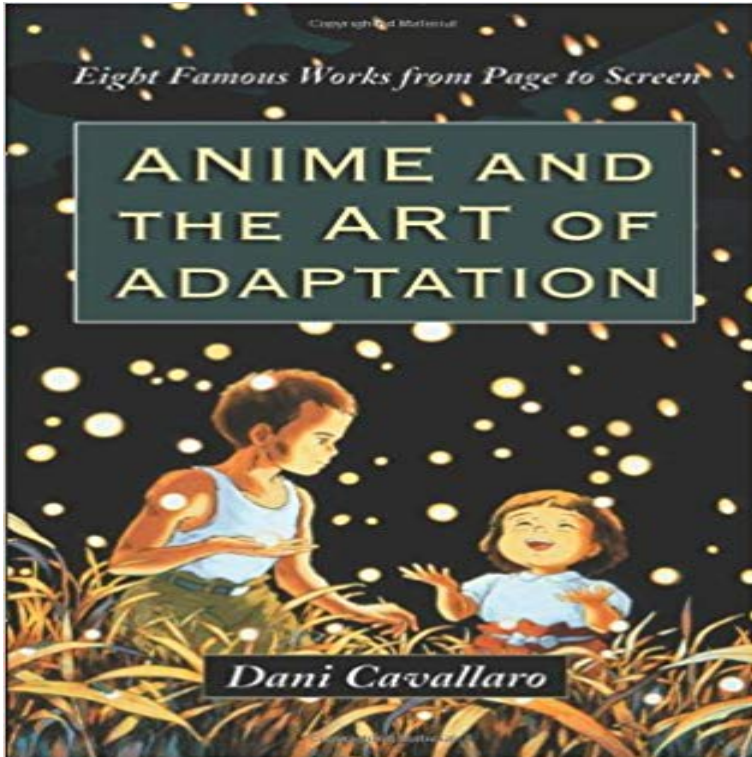


Anime and the Art of Adaptation: Eight Famous Works from Page to Screen
