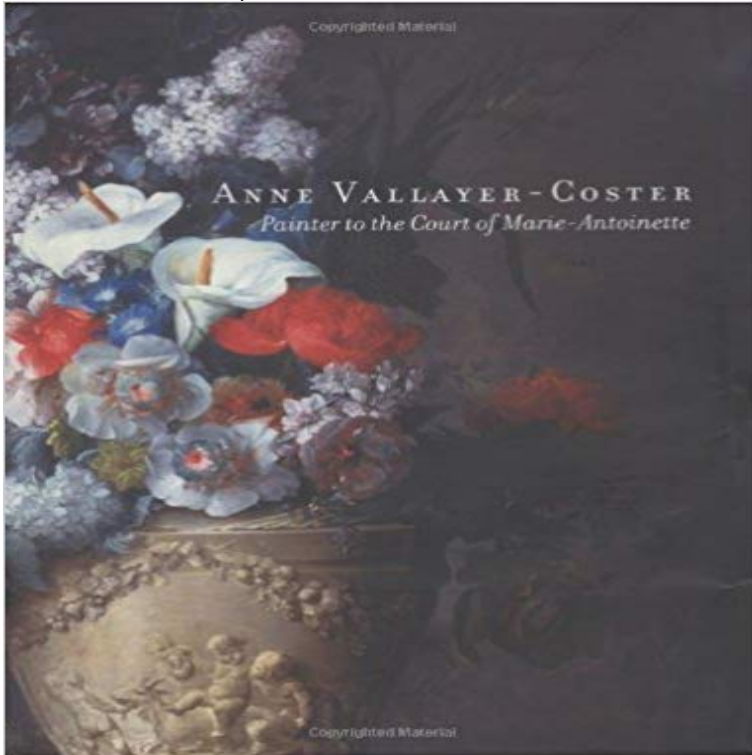


Anne Vallayer Coster: Painter to the Court of Marie Antoinette
