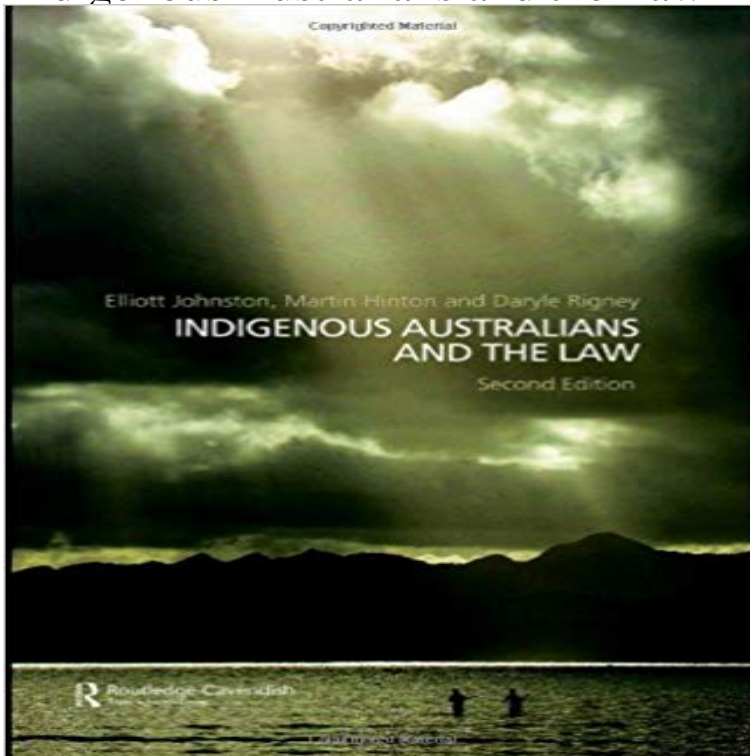


# Indigenous Australians and the Law
