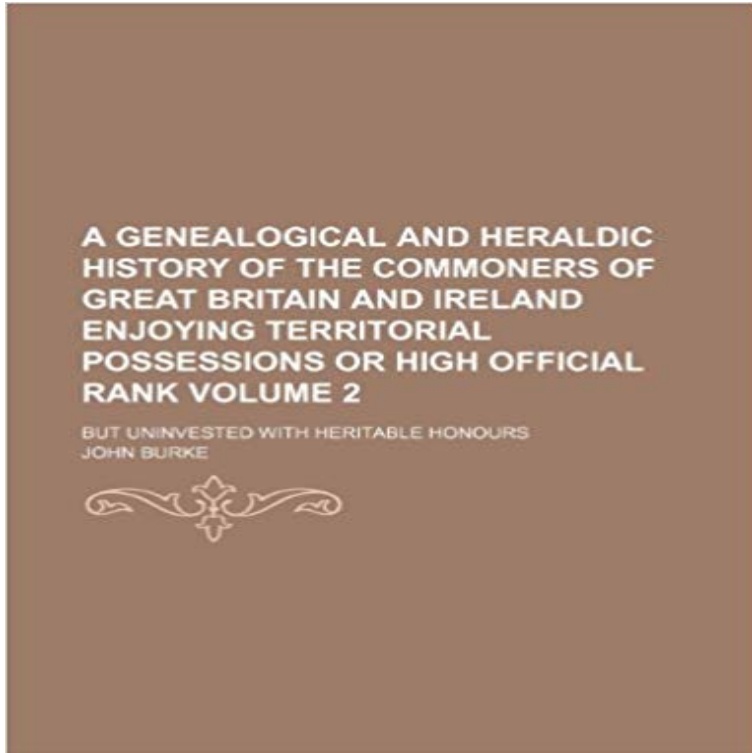

At last his Princes service called him borne, To die on Thamess hank, and leave this tombe To bear his name unto posteritie, And make all brave men love his memorie. Crawford states in his notes, that Robert Bruce, of Airth, was the Laird of Clackmannans brother, but the family of Airth never considered themselves a cadet of the Bruces of Clackmannan, nor have the family of Clackmannan any charter older than those of Airth to prove so.
