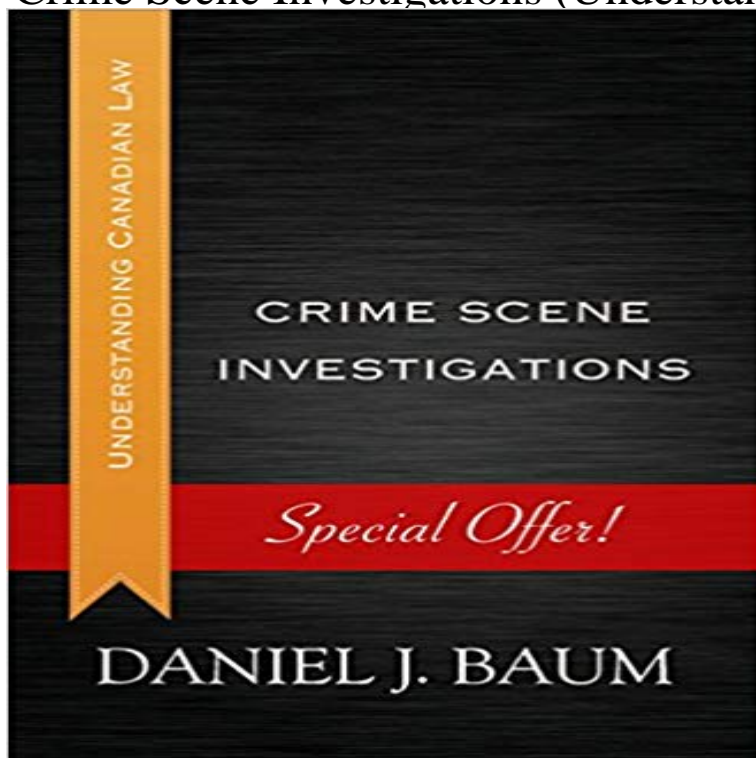


Crime Scene Investigations (Understanding Canadian Law)
