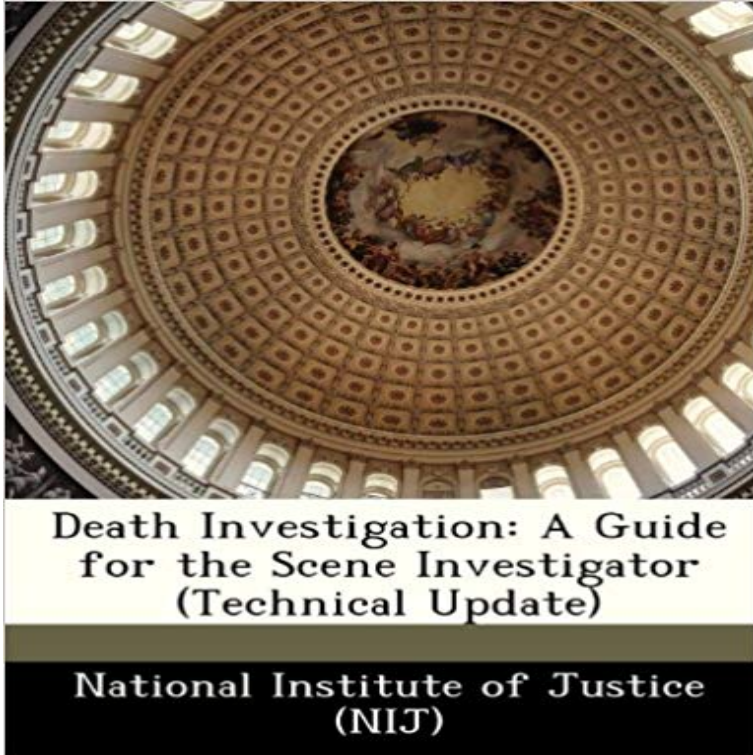


# Death Investigation: A Guide for the Scene Investigator (Technical Update)
