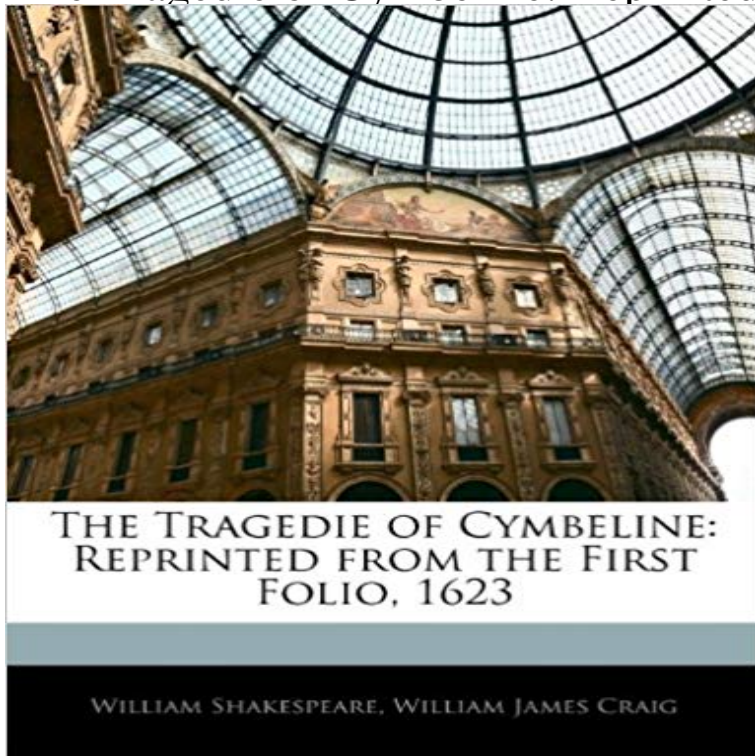


The Tragedie of Cymbeline: Reprinted from the First Folio, 1623
