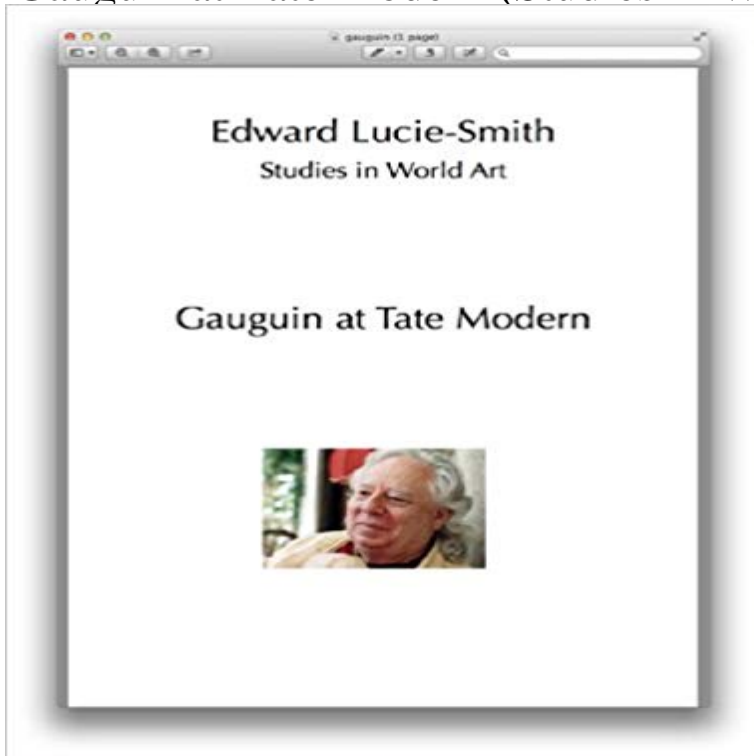


## Gauguin at Tate Modern (Studies in World Art Book 31)
