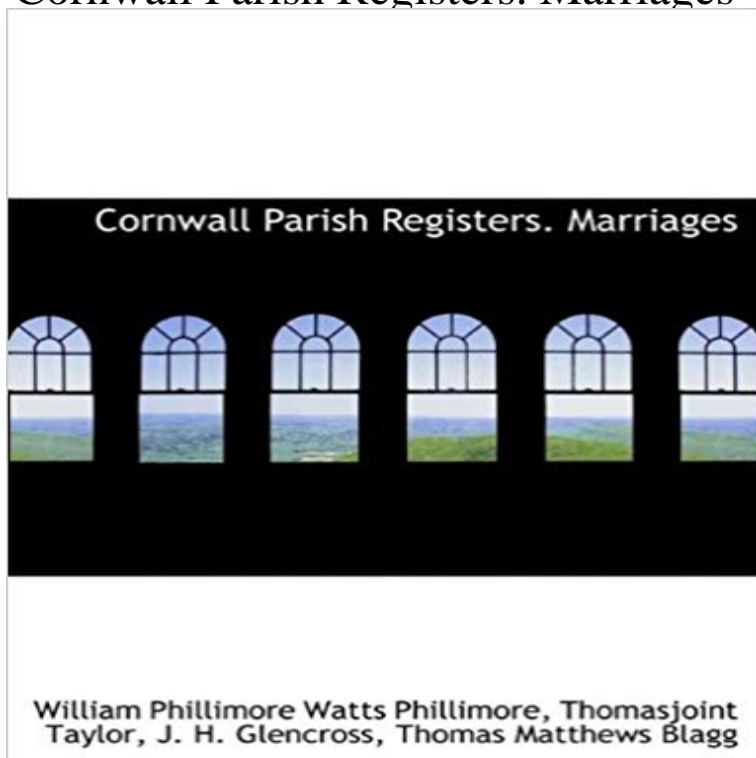


Cornwall Parish Registers. Marriages
