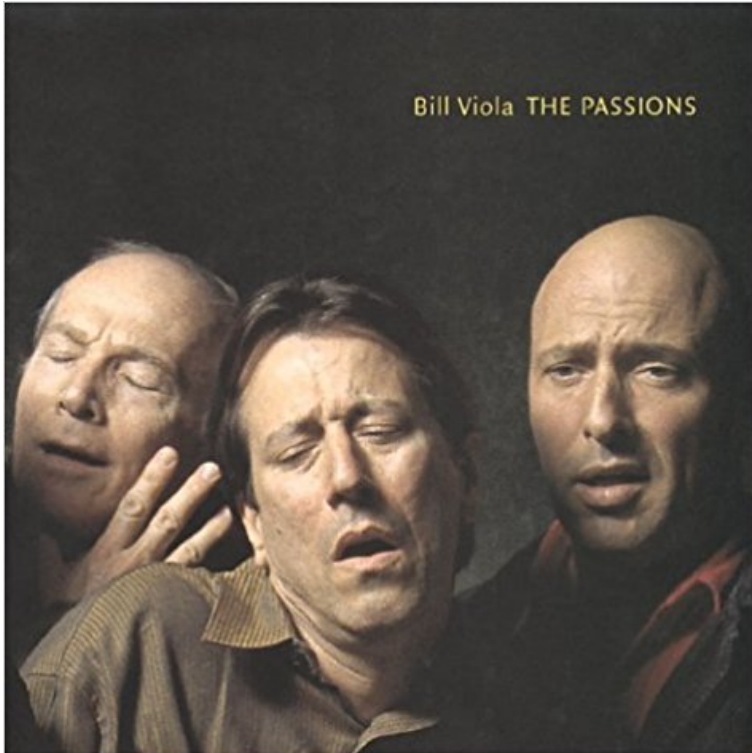


Bill Viola: The Passions



Human emotions are the subject of *The Passions*, a series of 20 video works made by the contemporary artist Bill Viola (b. 1951). Since the mid-1970s, Violas video installations have dealt with themes of perception, memory and self-knowledge. In these new works he has grappled with one of the oldest problems in art: how to convey the power and complexity of emotion by depicting the facial expressions and body language of models or, in Violas case, of performers. Written to accompany an exhibition on view at the Getty Museum from 24th January to 27th April 2003, and which will unveil *Emergence* - a new, commissioned work in the *Passions* series - this is an exploration of the genesis and meaning of this extraordinary suite of works. In an opening essay, John Walsh traces Violas career and examines the intellectual and psychological concerns that have preoccupied Viola over the years. Walsh then offers a first-person account of Violas filming of *Emergence*. A conversation between Viola and Hans Belting reveals Violas current interests and the role that older works of art have played in his development. Peter Sellars explores the spiritual foundation of Violas work. In addition, Viola presents both images and texts that served as sources for many of the *Passions* works. Finally, selected frames from the *Passions* works are reproduced, with explanatory notes by the artist.
