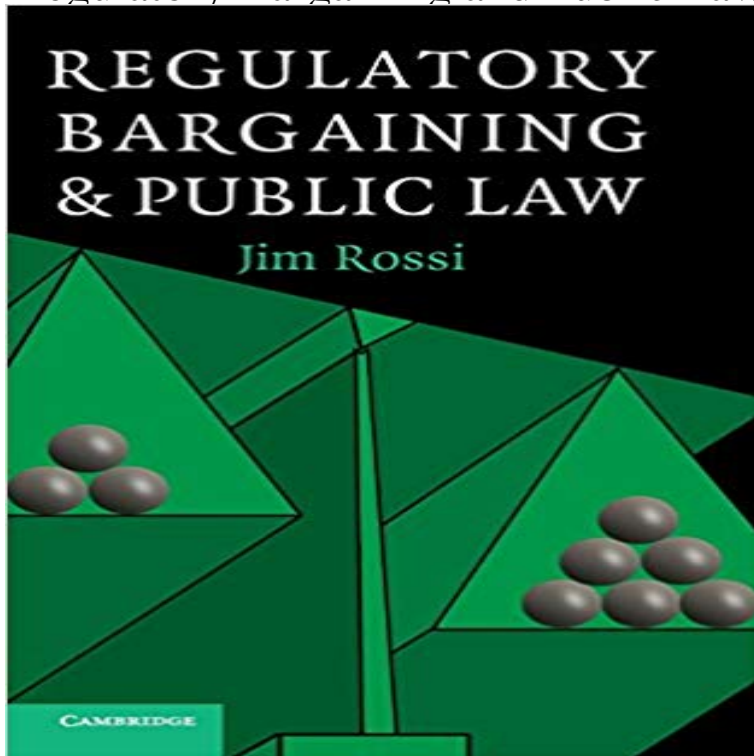


Regulatory Bargaining and Public Law

However, the author argues that governmental institutions, often influenced by private stakeholders, share blame for the defects in deregulated markets. The second part of the book explores the role of public law in a deregulatory environment, focusing on the positive and negative incentives it creates for the behavior of private stakeholders and public institutions in a bargaining-focused political process.
