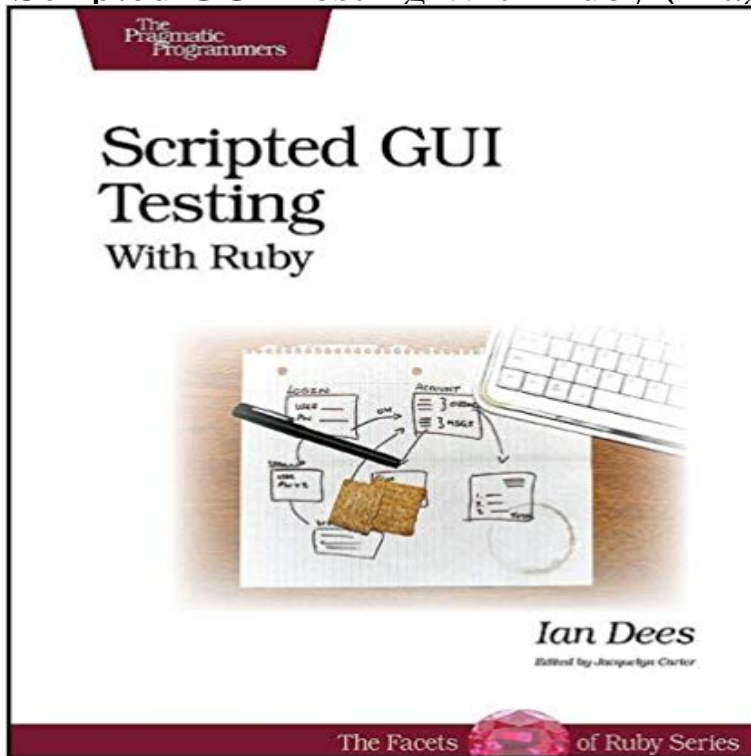


## Scripted GUI Testing With Ruby (Pragmatic Programmers)

You'll develop test scripts in Ruby; you don't need to be a Ruby expert, but basic comfort with the language will be helpful.
