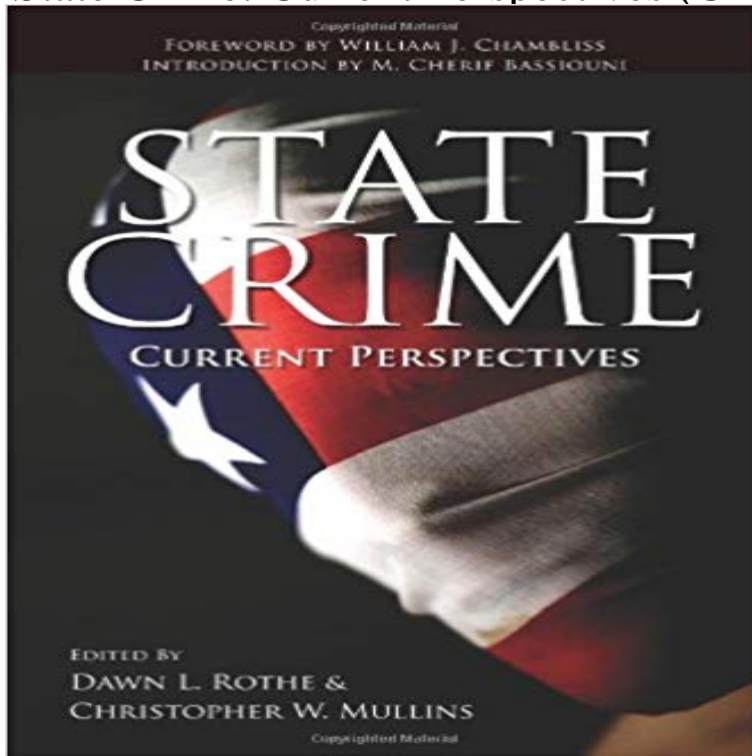


## State Crime: Current Perspectives (Critical Issues in Crime and Society)
