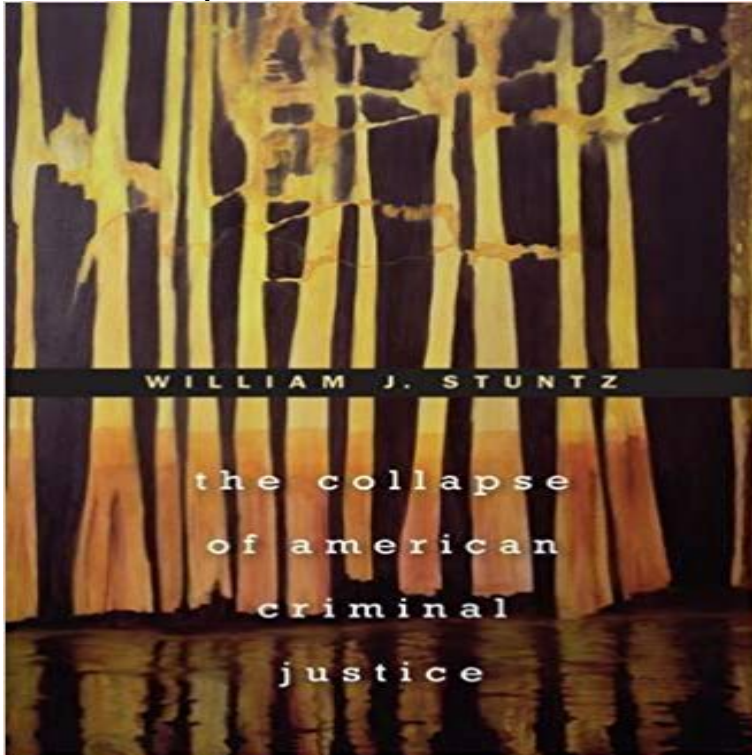


The Collapse of American Criminal Justice
